



Precautions and Contraindications to Yellow Fever Vaccine Administration

Contraindications:

Yes No

- *Allergy to vaccine component(s)*
- *Age <6 months*
- *Symptomatic HIV infections or CD4 T-lymphocytes < 200/mm³ (or <15% of total in children aged <6 years)*
- *Thymus disorder associated with abnormal immune-cell function*
- *Primary Immunodeficiencies*
- *Malignant neoplasms*
- *Transplantation*
- *Immunosuppressive and immunomodulatory therapies*

Precautions:

- *Age 6-8 months*
- *Age ≥60 years*
- *Asymptomatic HIV infection and CD4 T-lymphocytes 200-499/mm³ (or 15%-24% of total in children aged <6 years)*
- *Pregnancy*
- *Breastfeeding*
